Club EdVenture Outcomes

Report cards show 85% (190) improved their grade in Reading or stayed the same over the course of the year on curriculum-based measurement (CBM). Less than one percent (.19%) decreased their grade in Reading over the course of the year. Club EdVenture can contribute this success to our Facilitated Homework session and daily read-alouds.
